This document details the dues reduction agreement for PNC Plan 2. A HSHS band parent agreeing to this plan may earn up to **\$350** toward their student account by completing **10** events at the PNC Arena. The following are additional band details:

- An “event” is a hockey game, basketball game, or show that has been assigned by the PNC for the HSHS band to work concessions. This will usually be a cart selling pretzels or ice cream. Each event requires 2-3 workers. The PNC season typically runs from September to June.
- Shifts start 1.5-2.0 hours prior to the event. Work time is finished after the stand is closed, cleaned, and inventory/cash is reconciled with the leader. Typically, the duration of a shift is 4-5 hours.
- The student account will be credited **\$25 per shift** after the band boosters receive payment from PNC for that event. After the completion of your **10<sup>th</sup>** shift, a **\$100** bonus will be credited to your account and your contract will be complete.
- Once you have completed your original contract, you may continue to work events that are available at a rate of **\$30-\$40**, depending on the position you hold (leader or cashier).
- On occasion, we will be offered events from the PNC that require more hours, or bring in more money. Our shift payment may be higher for those events.
- By signing this contract, the October fair share payment of \$150 may be deferred until January 31<sup>st</sup> if the following conditions are met: 1. All previous fair share payments and other band fees must have been paid prior to the October fair share payment due date. 2. At least **3** of your PNC shifts must be completed by the end of December. 3. Any balance remaining after January 31<sup>st</sup> must be paid promptly to the Band Boosters. If you are unable to meet any of the conditions, this contract can be terminated and you will be responsible for the remaining balance on the student account without the assistance of the Dues Reduction Program.
- PNC dress codes must be followed at all times. You will need a black GHR polo shirt, black pants, black shoes and a GHR ball cap to volunteer. The shirt and cap need to be ordered by 1 August, and the order forms will be provided to you.
- Plan 2 participants are trained as cashiers and leaders during the course of their contract. Once the contract is met, leaders make **\$10** more per shift. Each event requires 1 leader and 1-2 cashiers.
- Any money credited to your child’s account that is not used during the current school year will be carried over to the next year, or it may be transferred to another child’s account. This allows you to earn more money now to help pay future year’s band dues. There will not be any cash refunds.
